- d) Explain why the Heckscher-Ohlin theory is a general equilibrium model. (6 Marks)

- b) Explain neutral, labour-saving and capital-saving technical progress. (6 Marks)
- c) Discuss how international trade can be based on product differentiation. (6 Marks)

- a) Using diagrams, explain effect of a tariff on consumer and producer surplus. (12 Marks)
- b) Explain why a nation's production possibility frontier is the same as its consumption frontier in the absence of trade. (8 Marks)
